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

# Radioactive and spent fuel management

### All EU Member States generate radioactive waste and have to manage it safely in the long term

- 16 MS with NPPs
  - (14 MS with operational NPPs)
- 21 MS with research reactors
- 1 case of shared NPP





- Adopted by the Council in August 2011
- Scope
  - responsible and safe long term spent fuel and radioactive waste management
  - applies to all MS
  - spent fuel and radioactive waste management, from generation to disposal (incl post-closure)
  - from civilian activities

#### **Purpose**



- Complement the EU legal basis on nuclear and radiation safety
- Legal requirements on SF/RAW from generation to disposal (incl post-closure)
- Focus on avoiding undue burdens to future generation
- Polluter pays principle

Based on international standards (IAEA) and convention (Joint Convention)

 All 28 MS are IAEA members and contracting parties to the JC

#### Status to date



- Implementation underway in all MS
- National Reports received from all MS
- Final National Programmes from 22 MS (5 drafts and 1 none)
- 3 MS concrete plans for geological disposal (FI 2022, FR and SE 2030)
- First intl. peer review in 2017 (PL and FR)
- 1st EC report to Parliament and Council beginning of 2017
- EC opinions on National Programmes in 2017

#### **Next steps**



- EC presentation of its 1<sup>st</sup> Report on implementation of the Directive and EU inventory – 1Q 2017
- Opinions on national programmes 2017
- EC feedback and lessons learned and discussion with MS on how to address common challenges and issues, 7-9 June 2017, Brussels
  - **Debate on share disposal solutions** (follow up on the ECA 22 (2016) report)
- EC Studies on inventories and cost assessments (2017-2018)
- Revision of ENSREG WG guidelines for MS reporting (next reporting – 23 Aug 2018)
